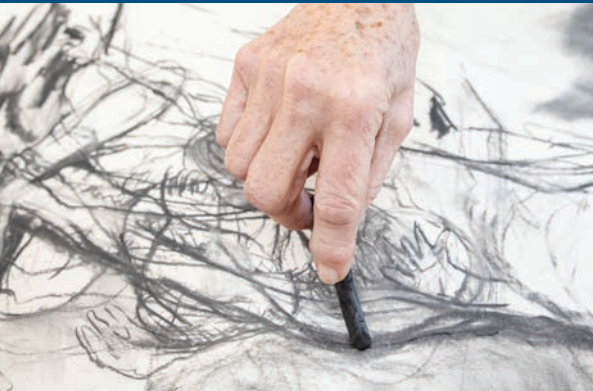
Inspire: Culture, Learning and Libraries supports Open Studios Notts by commissioning and curating exhibitions in their Library Galleries.
